UPDATE: COVID Oral Antiviral Medications

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW:

- Based on increasing availability of oral antiviral medications in Arizona, the AZ Department of Health Services expanded the patient prioritization to the "Tier 2" criteria.
- Prescribers should consider oral antiviral therapy for patients who meet Tier
 1 or Tier 2 criteria (summarized below).
- A select list of pharmacies are carrying oral antiviral products. Visit the site below for additional information and for the list of pharmacies to which Paxlovid may be prescribed.

PATIENT PRIORITIZATION:

- Tier One
 - Patients 70 years of age or older
 - OR who have major immune suppression (i.e., HIV, severe primary immunodeficiency, cancer and/or transplant patients, or patients on chronic steroids or other immunosuppressive drugs)
- Tier Two
 - Tier 1 and Age 50 years or older with one or more CDC high risk conditions for COVID-19 disease progression. CDC High Risk Health Conditions include (listed alphabetically):
 - Cancer
 - Chronic kidney disease
 - Chronic liver disease
 - Chronic lung diseases
 - Dementia or other neurological conditions
 - Diabetes (type 1 or 2)
 - Down syndrome
 - Heart conditions
 - HIV infection
 - Immunocompromised state (weakened immune system)
 - Mental health conditions

- Overweight and obesity
- Pregnancy
- Sickle cell disease or thalassemia
- Smoking & Tobacco Use
- Solid organ or blood stem cell transplant
- Stroke or cerebrovascular disease, which affects blood flow to the brain
- Substance use disorders
- Tuberculosis
