<p><b>Close contact</b></p>	<p>a. Being within approximately 6 feet of a COVID-19 case for a prolonged period; close contact can occur while caring for, living with, visiting, or sharing a healthcare waiting area or room with a COVID-19 case</p> <p>OR</p> <p>b. Having direct contact with infectious secretions of a COVID-19 case (ex. being coughed on)</p>
<p><b>High-risk Occupations</b></p>	<p>Healthcare personnel, school personnel, childcare worker, Nursing home caregivers, jail/prison personnel, or other similar occupation</p>
<p><b>Congregate setting (CDC definition)</b></p>	<p>Crowded public places where close contact with others may occur, such as shopping centers, movie theaters, stadiums</p>
