Prior Authorization Grids for 2022 Available on the Provider Website

IMPORTANT Changes to Prior Authorization Grid for Pharmacy

B - UFC/ACC and B - UFC/ALTCS

Effective January 1, 2022, Banner University Health Plans (BUHP) will update the Prior Authorization (PA) grid with the changes listed below. To find the PA grid for all BUHP plans, visit https://www.banneruhp.com/materials-and-services/prior-authorizations-and-referrals#Prior-Authorization-Grids.

We are also implementing Step Therapy for Part B drugs. Step Therapy will require a "first line" preferred agent to be attempted prior to a "second line" agent being approved. If the member has tried a first line agent in the past 365 days, this will allow the preferred agent to be reviewed and then potentially covered.
